Title: Maintenance Technicians

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt/Hourly

Reports to: Maintenance Coordinator

Job Summary: To provide maintenance services throughout downtown Stockton.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Customer Service

Expectation: Develop a positive, working relationship with Downtown businesses, property owners, City, and County to maintain a clean Downtown

- Supplies and Equipment

Expectation: Maintain equipment and monitor working environment to insure that safety for self, co-workers and the general public is "Job One" at all times..

- Recording Keeping

Expectation: Accurately complete time sheets and other documentation, as needed, and maintain open and honest communication with Maintenance Coordinator at all times.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of, and experience with, a variety of maintenance equipment, including power washers, blowers, pumps, tractors and hand tools is helpful, but not required
- Ability to communicate clearly and concisely in English

Credentials and Experience:

- Must be 18 years of age
- High School diploma or GED
- Current, valid California Driver License
- Out going, with friendly personality
- Customer Service background helpful, but not required

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions:

- Extended periods of walking and/or standing
- Some driving may be required
- Circulation throughout the downtown on foot and support for special events, outside in a variety of weather conditions, is required
- Hours may vary from the standard 8am – 5pm day, Monday – Friday week
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs.
