

Job Title: Wash Bay Operator

Reports to: Wash Bay Manager

Work Schedule: Must be able to work varied shifts including weekdays, weekends and holidays.

Principal Purpose of Job: Cleaning the interior of tanks using any of the equipment authorized.

Level of Authority: Receives close to moderate supervision. Expected to perform routine assignments as employee gains experience.

Work Environment: Works is primarily performed in outdoor environment subject to all kinds of weather. Work performed in this job will place the employee in elevated areas. Work performed will expose employee to wet conditions and will be using high pressure washing equipment.

Essential Job Functions: Proficiently operate all equipment necessary to complete job function.

Some tasks related to minor equipment maintenance and troubleshooting.

Some tasks related to janitorial care of the office buildings and restrooms and overall appearance and sanitary condition of the facility.

Respond to customer inquiries in a courteous manner within scope of knowledge and authority; refer to the Wash Bay manager as appropriate.

Qualifications: Must be at least 18 years old.

Be able to follow verbal and written instructions.

The ability to work with and get along with others.

Must use a variety of hand tools and pressure washing equipment.

Read and write English.

Basic computer skills.

Physical Qualifications: The physical strength and ability to perform moderate to heavy manual labor, including frequent bending, walking and lifting (up to 50) for extended periods under dirty and uncomfortable conditions and in all types of weather conditions.

Other: As an absolute condition of employment, employees are required to adhere to a drug and alcohol-free workplace environment.
